



Chief Rabbi inducts Rabbi Yechezkel Mandlebaum as Minister of Kingston, Surbiton and District Synagogue

Chief Rabbi Ephraim Mirvis has formally inducted Rabbi Yechezkel Mandlebaum as Minister of Kingston, Surbiton and District Synagogue in the presence of a large number of distinguished guests including Michael Goldstein, President of the United Synagogue, several former rabbonim of the KS&DS congregation, and a number of ministers from adjoining communities.
